This competition is being held in compliance with all Provincial Health and Safety orders as well as venue requirements for COVID-19.

Our goal is to allow our dancers to compete in a safe, calm, inclusive and positive environment. We appreciate unexpected situations will arise on the day that may require action that is meant to protect our dancers, judges, volunteers and other participants.

On the day of the competition, if you or any household family member has symptoms, has been diagnosed as having COVID-19, has been required to quarantine or self-isolate within the previous 14 days, – **please stay at home**. Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell, experiencing COVID-like symptoms, or if you have been asked by Public Health to self-isolate. Please note per Federal regulations, unvaccinated travelers (including children under the age of 12 years) who have been out of the country within the 14 days prior to the competition **will not be allowed to attend the competition**.

Please be respectful of all requests or you will be escorted from the facility.

Rules for attending ScotDance Canada Sanctioned Competitions:

- > On the competition day, entry into the competition will be allowed <u>only</u> after a QR code or contact tracing sheet has been signed and declaration of good health has been provided.
- On the competition day, entry to the competition will be allowed <u>only</u> after proof of vaccination (two doses plus 14 days) and valid identification has been provided for all participants (dancers and guardians) 12+ years of age.
- > On the day of the competition, if you are feeling unwell, experiencing COVID-like symptoms, or if you have been asked by Public Health to self-isolate, please stay home.
- If you test positive for COVID following the event, you must contact public health.
- This competition may be cancelled at any time up to and including on or during the day of competition.



- Masks <u>must</u> be worn by all entering the facility. Please bring your own mask! Dancers may choose to remove mask prior to going on stage for each dance. A bag will be provided for each dancer's mask, if they choose to remove it while competing.
- If a dancer chooses to wear a mask while on stage it must be devoid of any patterns or embellishments.
- Physical distancing strongly encouraged at all times while within the facility.
- > Only one parent/guardian is allowed in the facility with their dancer(s). Siblings with different registration times will not be allowed into the facility until their listed registration time.
- All competitors and their parents/guardians are required to exit the facility once their competition events are completed. An exception is where a parent/guardian may be volunteering, and even then, they must exit once their duties have been completed.
- There will be no costume changes and no space provided for costume changes at this time. Dancers are to arrive in costume prepared to dance, hair done and make-up applied. Please bring safety pins to affix number to dance costume.
- If dancer is bringing a personal water bottle, please mark name clearly on the outside. Bottle should be kept with dancer in the seating area. Bottle should not be taken to the line-up area.
- No garment bags will be allowed within the facility please leave unnecessary items in your car.
- > Two dance mats will be permitted per family and must be placed directly beside their seat.
- In order to facilitate the unique situation faced when organizing this event, dancers will be called to the marshalling (line-up) area in small groups almost immediately prior to competing. Dancers who do not arrive when called may forfeit their opportunity to compete for that event.
- > By entering the competition, you are agreeing to abide by all COVID-19 Protocols and Rules, all Competition Rules and all Public Health Orders as well as venue protocols.
- Results will be announced following each dance category, and awards will be given out as competitors exit the facility at the end of their competition time.
- > Washroom facilities will have limited occupancy depending on number of cubicles while maintaining physical distancing requirements.
- Provide your own personal hand sanitizer and Kleenex.
- Provide your own pen for sign-in-sheet. Good Heal Declaration (self-affirmation) will be required via a signature at the registration area if unable to scan the QR Code prior to entering the facility.

This competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (R.S.O.B.H.D.). Categories are defined by the R.S.O.B.H.D. Groups will be divided according to entries received. Numbers will be handed out on the day of the competition. Any complaint against the DRHDA or the adjudication of an event must be lodged in writing with the complainant's signature accompanied by a fee of \$25.00. Complaints must be lodged with the DRHDA Executive within 48 hours of the event for consideration at the next meeting.

EACH CATEGORY WILL BE GIVEN A REGISTRATION TIME. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE VENUE PRIOR TO YOUR REGISTRATION TIME. REGISTRATION TIMES WILL BE EMAILED ONE WEEK BEFORE THE EVENT.
