Choreography trophies will be presented at completion of the morning dances, before the morning awards, to allow dancers to change to their outfits for the afternoon competition.



November Choreography RULES for 2024

<u>In addition to the rules outlined for today's competition, the following rules will apply to our choreography event.</u>

- 1. This is a special event hosted by the DRHDA, open to registered and non-registered members.
- 2. Non members should add an additional \$20 non member fee per dancer if not competing in the regular competition event.
- 3. This event is open to all Pre-Premier and Premier dancers
- 4. Solo and group Choreography: Awards to 6 places
- 5. The adjudicator's decision is final. No communication can be entered into between teachers, parents or dancers with the adjudicator.
- 6. Any complaints or protests must be made in writing, accompanied by a fee of \$35. The complaint will be reviewed at a later date.
- 7. Music must be emailed to drhda.highlanddance@hotmail.com by Friday November 8, 2024 at 10:00PM
- 8. Age of the competitor to be determined as of 12.01am on competition date.
- 9. Dancers will receive numbers on the day of the competition. The number must be worn for all choreographies.
- 10. Choreography time limits:
 - a. Solo not to exceed 1 ½ minutes (includes entry & exit time)
 - b. Group not to exceed 3 minutes (includes entry & exit time)
 - c. We are limiting the solo choreography to the first **25 entries**, groups to the first **10 entries**.
- 11. Age categories will be determined by entries received. We reserve the right to combine or split age groups depending upon entries.
- 12. Average age of group entry will determine age groups
- 13. Dancers will perform as stated on the entry form. First to enter last to dance.
- 14. Registration for choreography will begin at 11:00 am. Competition will start at 11:30 am. All times are approximate.
- 15. Solo Choreography will commence immediately after the morning dancing followed by the Group Choreography. Awards will be done for all choreographies before the morning awards. Afternoon dances will commence shortly afterwards.
- 16. Group Choreographies:
 - a. A dancer can only compete in 1 choreography
 - In case of injury on day of competition, a substitute dancer must be listed on entry form (if dancer is not listed on entry form then the group cannot compete). Substitute must also be within same age class
 - c. All dancers must be from the same dance studio
- 17. Solo and Group Choreography music must be predominantly Scottish or Celtic in style. Costumes must follow the theme and content of the dance. **Group Choreography may also be a Christmas theme.**
